Change Financial Set-Up of Nfld. Development Co.

MONTREAL, (CP) - Premier Joseph Smallwood of Newfoundland announced Thursday a collection of firms headed by Canadian Javelin Foundries and Machine Works, Ltd., of Montreal, has purchased controlling interest in the Newfoundland and Labrador Corporation (Nalco) at a cost of \$7,500,000.

Simultaneously, he announced a major financial change in the structure of Canadian Javelin officially would be made known Friday.

Mr. Smallwood reserved his announcement until he detailed the nature of Nalco, established in 1951 by provincial statute as a cooperative venture between the Newfoundland government and private business to develop mineral and timber resources of both the island and Labrador.

Tells of Project. Mr. Smallwood sat in his shirt sleeves in a sweltering hotel room as he told reporters his project. Nalco is richer by 250,000 shares at five dollars a share and that a new board of directors had been named to the corporation.

John C. Doyle, president of Javelin, was named chairman of the executive committee and Dr. Alfred Faldemantis, former Newfoundland director-general of development, was named chairman of the board of directors.

The Newfoundland government's share-holding, originally a majority of 90 per cent, is now a minority of 36 per cent.

Nalco was originally capitalized at \$3,000,000 but the amount of authorized capital was later increased to \$5,000,000. Of the first million non-par-value shares sold at an arbitrary price of one dollar a share, the Newfoundland government bought 900,000.

Hugh Territory. Some 25,000 square miles of territory, which Mr. Smallwood said was 1,000 square miles bigger than Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island combined, was conceded to Nalco by the province for exclusive development.

Mr. Smallwood said the original \$1,000,000 simply could not be stretched to cover the territory involved and heavier capitalization was needed to develop "exciting finds" made by survey and prospecting parties in the wilds of Labrador and on Newfoundland itself.

"Since there was a question of whether it was right to risk public funds on such things as mineral developments," Mr. Smallwood said "the province would buy no more shares in Nalco and would become a minority investor if private firms could be found to buy enough shares to put the government in 'the minority'."
