WINNIPEG, Dec. 12 (CP) - All prices except oats moved to higher levels in moderately active trade today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Dealings in oats were less active than in other grains, with only routine shipper demand and light offerings in evidence. Export buying contributed to barley's advance. The demand came in connection with reports of 500-600 bushels of Canadian barley being sold to Norway and the Netherlands. Industrial interests picked up flax, while rye trade was local. No information was available on export loadings of Canadian wheat. Prices for class two wheat and 1 W. A. were up one-half cent from yesterday. THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT Four attention is directed to the following provisions of the said Act: SECTION 66 SUB-SECTION (4) Where any work within the scope of this Part is undertaken by a contractor or contractors, the person for whom such work is undertaken shall, within seven days after the making of any such contract notify the Board in writing of the making of such contract or contracts and in such notice shall state: (a) the name and address of the contractor or contractors; (b) The nature of the work to be performed by the contractor or contractors; (c) the amount payable under the contract, whether a lump sum or in proportion to the amount of work done, and in the latter case give the full particulars; (d) the probable length of time for completion of the work to be performed by the contractor or contractors.
