MONTREAL, June 14—(CP)—Receipts on Montreal livestock markets today were 42 cattle, 24 sheep and lambs, 59 hogs and 135 calves. The few lambs offered were sold down to \$5. Drinkers were \$4 to \$4.50. The few lambs offered were sold in mixed lots at \$11 per cwt. Sheep ranged from \$2.50 to \$4. Bacon was \$9.25 fed and watered and \$9.50 off trucks. Selects drew \$1 premium, with the regular cuts on off grades. Sows were from \$5 to \$5.50. Hogs sold on rail grades brought \$12.70 for bacon cold weight. On Maritime markets rail grade hogs advanced 20 cents to 8.00 up hot weight. Live grade hogs off trucks were \$8.65. Sows on rail grade made \$6.85 and live grade \$5.15.
