## Theatre PEI's Fall Workshops A Success -- Public Invited To Attend Demonstrations

Earlier in the fall Theatre PEI Artistic Director Rob MacLean programmed three public workshop series on playwriting, improv and stage lighting. The stage lighting class is just underway with instructor Paul Druet, but now at the culmination of the other workshops Theatre PEI presents two demonstration evenings free to the public.

**Monday, November 17 @ 8 PM in the Duffy Amphitheatre on the UPEI campus,** the ATV playwright's group will gather to read some of the work that has been generated in class and on individual new plays.

Rob MacLean, leader of the workshop says:

*"I thought it would be a good idea to explore playwriting with a group of people, to encourage new Island voices to try their hand at this amazing craft. The class has been exploring where playwriting ideas come from, what makes a scene playable on the stage, and how to choose scenes that will lead an audience through the story. What we will be showing the audience is a sampling of the process of playwriting, illustrated by some of the writing assignments we have done in class and some of the very beginning work on new plays that has started. I've been impressed with how playful and creative people in the group are. Our meetings have been a lot of fun, because they've been so willing to explore and try new things."*

The second demonstration evening will be held on **Thursday, December 4th @ 8 PM at the Arts Guild** featuring the Island Tel Improv Workshop class. Improvisation has been called the Jazz of theatre, teaching actors to think on their feet, to react spontaneously and to trust their instincts. The Improv series has also received support from the PEI Department of Education.

Enrollment for the Improv Workshop was so high that a second session to take place in January and February has already been filled up.
