I have thought fit, by and with the advice of Her Majesty's Executive Council, further to prorogue the said General Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued until TUESDAY, the Sixth day of JULY next, of which all persons concerned are required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

*Given under my hand and the Great Seal of this Island, at Charlottetown, in the said Island, this Twenty-seventh day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine, and in the thirty-second year of Her Majesty's reign.*

## NOTICE.
