NEW YORK (CP)—The Canadian dollar was 1-32 of a cent higher at a premium of 3-32 per cent in terms of U. S. funds Thursday. Pound sterling up 1-32 of a cent at \$2.80 3-16.

**Grains**  
WINNIPEG (CP) — Unfavorable harvest weather and forecasts of further frost for northern Alberta prompted good demand for most grains Thursday on the Winnipeg grain exchange. All grains except rye scored good gains.

Rye was sold off following reports that Germany had postponed the purchase of a large shipment of North American rye.

Overnight export loadings of Canadian wheat — about 3,400,000 bushels — were believed to be the largest one-day total of the current season, and included: United Kingdom 1,700,000 bushels; Yugoslavia 750,000; Netherlands 370,000; Germany 335,000; Japan 230,000; Colombia 50,000.
