

Failing To Stop At Accident Brings Two Fines

SUMMERSIDE — James Emmanuel Connors, RCAF Station Chatham, and Gerald MacCarville, Freetown, appeared yesterday in town police court on charges of failing to stop at the scene of an accident.

Connors was fined \$10 and costs or 10 days and MacCarville pleaded not guilty and had his case adjourned to July 6.

A Kinkora man, Richard Charles Johnston, pleaded guilty to a charge of impaired driving and had his case adjourned to July 6.

Nelson MacKay of Summerside pleaded not guilty to a charge of assault and had his case adjourned to July 22.

Eldon Casey of Summerside was fined \$5 and costs or 10 days on a charge of failing to sign his driver's license.

Hartford, MacAusland of Summerside was fined \$10 and costs or 10 days on a speeding charge.

Daniel Andrew Legourriere of RCAF Station Summerside was fined \$10 and costs or 10 days on a charge of failing to have the registration of a motor vehicle transferred.

Two accused were charged with being drunk. One was fined \$20 and costs or 10 days and the other was fined \$20 and costs or one day.

Woodlots Here Under Survey

Provincial forestry department personnel and members of the forestry department of the University of New Brunswick will be examining various Island woodlots in July and August in an ARDA forest land capability survey, it was announced yesterday.

Purpose of the survey is to get an inventory of the production of Island forests and to gain a basis for future forest management.

Provincial forester Frank Gaudet, assistant Ian Millar, UNB forestry dean Dr. John Ker, and professors N. L. Kissick and W. Hilborn will be conducting the survey, which covers all three counties.

The survey will continue next summer.

Protest Group Meets Today With Cabinet

A delegation of Summerside area residents protesting the site of a new liquor store on Granville Street is expected to meet with the provincial cabinet today.

Premier Walter R. Shaw said yesterday the delegation is welcome and the protest will be listened to by cabinet. He added, however, that the protest should be referred to the P.E.I. Liquor Control Commission.

"After all," the premier said "the commission has the power to decide for itself where liquor outlets will be located."

BATTLE WITH BANDITS

GOGOTA, Colombia (Reuters)—A total of 76 bandits and 10 soldiers were killed last month in gun battles during nation-wide operations aimed at curbing banditry in Colombia, military sources said Sunday. In addition, 46 bandits were captured and imprisoned and some 300 firearms were confiscated.
