Bows accent detail at the empire line of a short gown or, tipped with fringe, pose on a more tailored tail.

Fabrics are becoming more imaginative too. In addition to the ever-popular georgette and tulle, there are rayon, chiffone for summertime weddings, cotton failles, silk-faced satins and many synthetic fibers.
