

New President Has Program To Aid Dominican Republic

SANTO DOMINGO, Dominican Republic (Reuters)—Juan Bosch, 45-year-old novelist and short story writer, is preparing to launch a program of major economic and social reforms after he is inaugurated as president of the Dominican Republic.

The nation's first freely elected president in more than 20 years, Bosch spent 24 years of that time in exile as an enemy of the late dictator, Rafael Trujillo, who was assassinated in May, 1961.

Under present plans, the president-elect will be sworn in for a four-year term Feb. 27. Shortly after the elections in December, he flew to the United States for a visit to his son, at school in Indianapolis, and to Europe for a three-week visit.
