

## N. Lake To Have Cold Storage

A Government decision to establish cold storage at a half-hold, the facilities in North Lake and other areas of the Island was announced by Provincial Minister of Fisheries Leo Rossiter at a Progressive Conservative rally held in St. Margarets Thursday night. The Minister said that the new cold storage plant to be constructed at North Lake would be available for use to all fishermen, as well as farmers for beef storage. The Shaw Government would undertake to finance the cost of this and other units. Mr. Rossiter said.

The Minister of Fisheries also said the government will take advantage of the ARDA program to assist groups of producers who wish to join together to develop the blueberry industry in this area.

Sharing the platform with the Fisheries Minister were the First Kings Progressive Conservative Candidates, Peter MacAulay and Highway Minister Keith MacKenzie, as well as Mel McQuaid M.P. for Kings.

Mr. MacAulay praised the "foresight and courage of the Shaw Government" for the fact that Prince Edward Island has now moved ahead of the rest of the country in regard to Old Age

Penions. He quoted from a Canadian Press story in the Charlottetown press in which Mr. Pearson was reported as saying:

**LIBERALS DETERMINED**  
The Federal Liberals are determined to freeze Old Age Pensions at \$75 a month. Mr. MacAulay said. He pointed out that the Federal Government refused to supply the Shaw administration with the names of those Islanders presently receiving the \$75 Old Age Pension so that the extra \$25 now provided by the Provincial Government could be paid without going through the process of registration.

Despite the lack of federal co-operation, the Shaw Government found a way around this liberal blockade by setting up special offices throughout the Island so that all senior citizens could register their names. As a result of this new successful registration, the new provincial pensions are now being paid, Mr. MacAulay said.

He told the meeting that efforts by provincial Liberals to persuade Islanders to boycott the registration "failed miserably." It is a fact, he said, that the provincial Liberals had no intention of paying the extra Old Age Pension benefits until next year, if at all. If this were not so, and if they had the interest of the pensioners at heart, they would have welcomed the decision of the Shaw Government and urged our older people to register.
