Flushed with the success of a record year in 1963, and with booming sales of 1964 models and riding what they see as a tide of growing prosperity, the auto makers are enthusiastically optimistic in their year-end reviews and new-year forecasts.

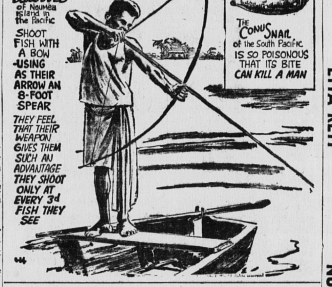
