Coconut Fudge Chiffon Cake

Sift into a bowl, 1 c. plus 2 tbs. once-sifted cake flour, 1 1/2 tps. Magic Baking Powder, 1/2 tsp. salt, 1/4 c. fine granulated sugar; mix in 1/2 c. desiccated coconut. Make a well in dry ingredients and add in order given (do not stir mixture), 1/4 c. corn (sifted) oil, 2 1/2 beaten egg yolks, 1/4 c. plus 2 tbs. water, 1 tsp. vanilla, 2 1/2 ozs. unwetted chocolate, melted and cooled. Stir liquids a bit, then stir in dry ingredients; beat until batter is smooth.
