

WINTER BUSINESS RACING REVIEW

Best Racing Season Of A Time Is Reviewed With More Horses Racing, More Spectators, Than Any Previous Year And More Money Paid Out In Purses.

HERE THEY ARE !!

Fastest racing, with more 2:10 miles, more night racing and more money in purses featured what was the Maritime's best year. Nine night racing plants were in operation—Sydney, Truro, Sackville Downs, N.S., Charlottetown and Summerside, P.E.I. and Moncton, Saint John, Fredericton and Woodstock, N.B.

They paid out as follows: Sackville—Downs, \$10,875; Saint John, \$96,830; Truro, \$73,688; Moncton, \$85,200; Charlottetown, \$64,075; Fredericton, \$60,832; Summerside, \$48,776; Woodstock, \$31,700; Summerside, \$37,000; Chatham, \$3,700; Moncton, \$800, a total of \$344,798. In addition, races were held by horsemen's clubs at Halifax and Truro, with the former paying out \$14,026 and the latter \$2,920.

RIC PURSES

The Moncton, for a purse of \$2,000, was held at Moncton on July 15 and was won by Newport Chief 3, 1:39. driven by C. Cruikshank. Time, 2:06 3/5. Another Free For All race was raced over the same track on Aug. 22, and was won by Mr. 2:03 2/5. A. Langille and Convar 2, 2:01 1/4. Mauder, dead heat for first place in a 3-horse race, 2:06 4/5 and Convar 2, each 2:06 4/5. Another race which equalled the track pacing record held by Dave Granton 2:05 2/5. Saint John also had a \$2,000 Free For All Invitational on Sept. 19. J. R. Nightingale 2:06, P. McNeil won the race. Total purses, \$308,355 and Josedale Classman 2:07 1/4. (Fr. Truro); the second in 3:16.

Two Free For All's were raced at Charlottetown during October. The first was on Aug. 12, and was won by Old Home No. 10, 2:17. On Oct. 12, the Free For All race, a purse of \$1,500 was won in three straight heats by Newport Chief 3, 1:59 (B. Cruikshank). Time, 2:09. 2:09 1/5, 2:12 2/5. On August 18, an \$1,000 Free For All was raced with Convar 3, 2:01 1/4 (Mauger). Time, 2:06. 2:07 1/4, 2:07 1/4. The fastest three heats paid in the Maritimes.

Free For All was raced at Sackville Downs on October 12. Jacky Lad 2:08 2/5. G. Turner was 1:11. Time, 2:10 2/5, 2:10 2/5. The Miramichi Stake, purse \$1,500, was raced at Chatham on July 15. It was won by Hal's Mae (C. Killam) in the race-off with Marjand Joan T. Collier. Time, 2:10.

TRACK RECORDS
New track records were made at Saint John when Kabin 2 (E. Kirkpatrick) on October 14, won 2:08, and the trotting record was broken Oct. 16, by W. C. Brooks (W. Carr) when he trotted in 2:12. At Sackville Downs a new track pacing record was made by Fred Scott 1:54. Paces on Sept. 2, time 2:06 4/5, and a new trotting record of 2:16 was made by Memory Song (J. J. Givens) on November 11th.

MARITIME RECORD
One of the most sensational performances of the year was the lowering of the Maritime record for 2-year-old trotters by L. G. 4, Lakelburn, owned and driven by Dr. J. T. Akins, Fredericton, at Fredericton Oct. 14, when she stepped in 2:08 3/5. Another excellent performance was that of the 2-year-old gelding Hal Again No. 5, D. Hal, at Fredericton September 19, when he paced in a record of 2:16 4/5, the fastest performance ever made by a 2-year-old pacer in this country. Two other pacers, the get of N. D. Hal, both 2-year-olds, Hal's Mae and Hal's Man, took records of 2:09 3/5.
