THE SEARCH committee invites nominations or applications of qualified candidates for the position of Dean of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Prince Edward Island. The committee is looking for an internal candidate who, if successful, would take up the position as of July 1, 1989.

The committee will accept nominations or applications from within the University committee. The post is open to all eligible faculty who have a DVM degree or its equivalent, including the incumbent Dean.

Candidates should have a record of achievement in teaching and scholarly activity, an established reputation for research and creativity, and a demonstrated ability to related to others: e.g., university units, professional prganizations, communities.

Nominations should be sent to the Committee Chairperson, Dr. David Seeler, Department of Companion Animals, UPEI, by April 5, 1988. Nominators must ensure that their candidate is willing to stand to submitting the candidate's name.
