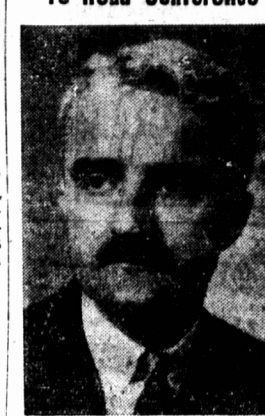

Functions Of The Provincial Mental Health Hospital And The Mental Health Clinic

As Medical Superintendent of Falconwood Hospital and Director of the Division of Mental Health for the Province, it affords me much pleasure to endorse the excellent precepts that are publicized during Mental Health Week, May 2-8; this week has been designated as such by the Canadian Mental Health Association.

At present this clinic functions as a part-time clinic, essentially in a consultant and advisory capacity in matters pertaining to mental health problems in adults and children. Cases reporting are referred by their attending or family physician on referral forms.

At Falconwood Hospital we have made considerable progress in providing various therapeutic measures for the treatment of mental illness and have provided occupational and recreational activities, which are essentially therapeutic procedures.

Consistent services have been instituted in cancer, tuberculosis, neurology and psychiatry. The services of a neurosurgeon has been made available for lobotomy operations. All new admissions are x-rayed, an ambulance service has been provided for the transportation of patients to and from the various hospitals, when special surgical or medical attention is indicated.
