This week's article is about the undergraduate deadlines for upcoming bursaries, but first I wanted to thank a couple of special groups for their valued participation in the work of Financial Aid. I also want to thank those students who were involved with Prof. F. Falvo and the Scholarship Promotion Committee's Graduate Study Meeting also held on Friday, Feb. 12. Both events reflected genuine concern and positive participation for an area that should be - and is - important to all of us.

The bursaries with upcoming deadlines are:

**CANADIAN NATIONAL EXHIBITION - 4H Club** - Open to students in Agriculture, Veterinary, or Home Economics disciplines, with others considered. Applicants must have 2 years work in 4H club, and entering second or third year in Agriculture or Home Economics Degree Program. Valued at \$1000. Deadline: May 1.

**CANADIAN ASSOCIATION OF BROADCASTERS** - communications. Open to students in Broadcasting & Journalism, or those taking Communication courses, Broadcast Journalism, French Broadcasters. \$1000. to \$5000 value. Deadline: April 30.

**COMMUNITY OF WEST ROYALTY/PETER MEINCKE AWARD** - Open to students who have excelled in community services. Valued at \$200.

**EVELYNE M. CUDMORE SCHOLARSHIP** - Open to students in any field of study. Applicants must be a UPEI student or an Island student studying at another university in another discipline not available at UPEI, and must be employed with or have worked for the Red Cross. Valued at \$1000.

**T. ARTHUR DAWSON MASONIC SCHOLARSHIP** - Open to students in any field of study who are children of Freemasons of PEI. Valued at \$500.

**DIETETICS AWARDS** - Open to Dietetics, Senior and intending to take Dietetic Internship. Valued at \$500., \$750., and \$1000.

**GEORGE & NORA ELWIN SCHOLARSHIP** (McMaster University) - Open to students in Arts, Sciences,

Business, Engineering, Nursing, or Phys.Ed. with exceptional academic standing to attend McMaster University. Valued at \$2500. Deadline March 29.

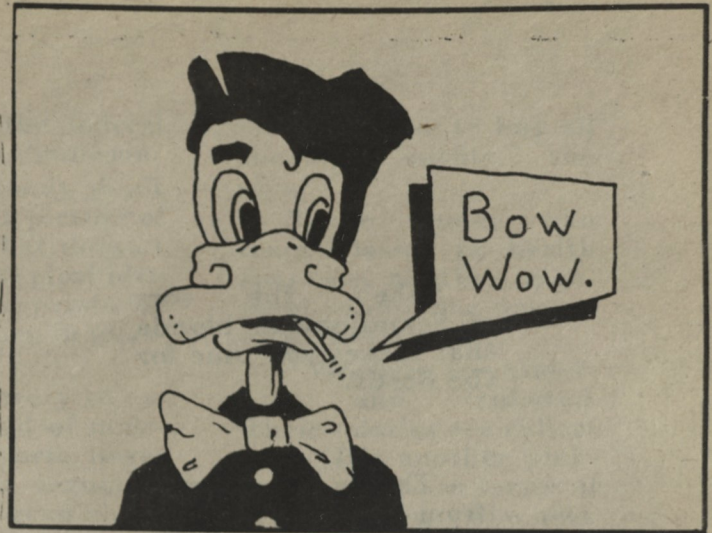
**ORVILLE ERICKSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND** - Open to students in Conservation who plan to pursue a career in such. valued at up to \$1000.

**HELEN HERRING** - Open to Senior Home Economics students studying for a degree in Home Economics who are a resident of PEI. Valued at \$500. Deadline: April 30.

**KIDNEY FOUNDATION** - Open to students in Science or Medicine whose research project must be related to kidney or urinary tract. Valued at \$2000. for a 12 week summer student fellowship. Deadline: Feb. 28.

**NEW BRUNSWICK HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP** - Open to students in Home Economics with 2 year college training in Home Economics and are a resident of NB. Valued at \$1000. Deadline: May 31.

**THE PETRO CANADA 4H YOUTH LEADERSHIP AWARD** - Open to student in any field of study who has been involved in 4H and



is entering 1st year in university, college, or technical training school. Valued at \$1000.

**THE PLANETARY SOCIETY COLLEGE FELLOWSHIP AWARD** - Open to students in Engineering and Sciences. Based on scholastic achievement, a commitment of a career in planetary related science, and a written essay on a relevant topic. Five grants valued at \$1000. each. Deadline: April 15.

**ROTARY CLUB OF CHARLOTTETOWN** - Open to students in any field of study who are physically disabled. Valued at \$2000. Deadline: April 15.

**ROTARY FOUNDATION OF ROTARY INTERNATIONAL** - Open to students in any field of study who is an ambassador of goodwill in

a country of choice to study. Round trip transportation, education & living expenses provided. Deadline: March 1 (1 1/2 years prior to year of study)

**ST. JOHN'S UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S CLUB** - Open to students in Home Economics who is a female graduate from a NB High School in St. John or King's County, entering Senior year in University. Valued at \$600. Deadline: March 31.
