West ruffed and returned a trump. Declarer had to lose another trick and went down two. When the Italian North-South pair played the hand at the other table, they also reached six clubs. The American West opened his singleton spade and Foguet, declarer, played the ace. A spade return led to the king and a low spade back was ruffed with the jack. A diamond to the ace was followed by a heart to the ace. The K-Q of diamonds were cashed, heart and a spade being discarded from dummy. A crossruff ensued, dummy's two remaining spades being trumped with the A-Q of clubs, and declarer's two losing hearts being ruffed in dummy. The K-10 of clubs took the last two tricks and the slam was made.

B. C. Paper Joins C.P.

TORONTO (CP)—The Prince George, B.C., Citizen Monday became a member of the Canadian Press, the national news co-operative. The Citizen, founded in 1916, has been published twice weekly since October, 1950. Its circulation is more than 6,000. Today it starts publishing five days a week. It brings to 98 the number of Canadian dailies exchanging their news through CP and receiving its world news service. Prince George, 340 miles north of Vancouver, has doubled its population to 10,000 in five years. It is at the junction of the Pacific Great Eastern Railway and the Canadian National Railway's northern line from Edmonton to Prince Rupert.
