

Garfield & Odie

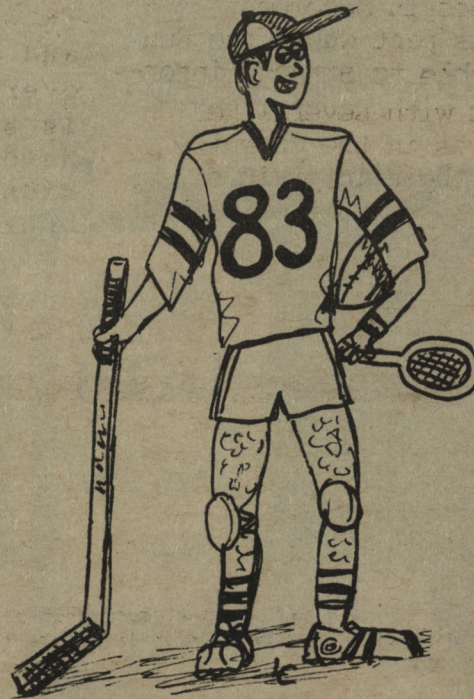
