The entire front of the National Park, for instance, is a solid unbroken 25 miles of beach equal to the best anywhere in the world. Visitors from many parts of the United States and Canada come back year after year to swim in the warm salt waters of Canada's Garden Province.

Tourist Accomodations

Accommodation in Prince Edward Island consists of modern hotels, cottages, hotels, tourist homes, and special camping facilities for those families who prefer camping out. Most resorts are located close to beaches, particularly units along the North Shore, in Charlottetown, Summerside and Keppoch. The hotels and many of the cottage colonies and cabins have their own central dining rooms. But there are also many resorts where the individual cottages are equipped for housekeeping facilities. Moderate rates prevail at all Prince Edward Island resorts.
