Macquarrie Is Convinced Canada Should Join OAS

OTTAWA — A Canadian political scientist and member of parliament, Health Macquarrie, MP for Queens, Prince Edward Island, remains firmly convinced that Canada should join the Organization of American States. Canada's membership in the Pan American Union is one of the subjects to be discussed by prime minister Pearson and President Kennedy this weekend.

Mr. Macquarrie, now an opposition member, was parliamentary secretary to former external affairs minister Howard Green. In that position he was able to exert some influence on Canadian policy but was not able to convince Mr. Green and the other members of the cabinet that Canada should join the OAS.

"It will be interesting to watch what action the Liberal government takes on this matter in view of their declared policy of Canadian membership," Mr. Macquarrie said here this week. "It is easy for an opposition party to make commitments but they some times have second thoughts when they assume power."

The P.E.I. member, who has made a special study of Latin America and of OAS in particular, admits the current dispute between Haiti and the Dominican Republic presents a real test of the power and unity of the largely Latin American organization. But he argues that whatever happens in this dispute, the OAS has proven its value in other political and non-political roles over the years.

"Canada is a member of a good many international bodies and is actively discharging its duties to them. Why then are we not a member of an organization in our own hemisphere, the oldest peaceful international organization in the world?" Mr. Macquarrie asks. Simon Bolivar was the spiritual father of OAS and called the Panama Conference in 1826 to deal with the threat from Europe to the freedom of the newly independent Central and South American states. Alberton Lady To Speak Sun. In Montague

OTTAWA (CP)—Prime Minister Pearson denied today policy statements attributed to him by the Boston Globe.

Among other things, the newspaper said the Canadian prime minister had told Globe reporter Leonard Lerner in an interview that Canada would announce shortly plans to join the Organization of American States. He quoted Mr. Pearson saying a Canadian-Soviet nuclear pact is nearly ready for signature.

Going into a cabinet meeting today, Mr. Pearson told reporters he had spent a few minutes Wednesday with a Globe reporter who was supposed to be writing a profile story on the prime minister.

Mr. Pearson added: "There is absolutely no foundation for the conclusions in the story. They are both speculative and imaginary."

U.S. ADMIRAL IN OTTAWA
OTTAWA (CP)—Admiral George W. Anderson Jr., chief of naval operations, U.S. Navy, arrived here by air from Washington Thursday for two days of defence talks with Canadian officials. He told a reporter on subject he will discuss with Vice Adm. Herbert Rayner, chief of Canadian naval staff, will be the current Canadian naval program of building helicopter landing platforms and hangars on destroyers.

Montague Food Plant Plans Sept. Operations

Food processing at the Fraser Valley Frozen Food Company Limited plant in Montague will begin in September, it was learned yesterday.

The only crop to be processed in the 1963 season will be Brussels sprouts and the company will require between 175 and 200 acres of this crop. Following the processing of Brussels sprouts, the plant will process fish and chips throughout next winter.

Provincial research director, Hartwell Daley, said yesterday there has been some anxiety in the Montague area over the new plant which began operations.

"I was in contact Wednesday night" said Mr. Daley, "with the company's Chilliwack, B.C., plant manager, Kurt Blondell, who told me the plant will become operative in September."

Mr. Daley said a meeting of prospective growers for the plant will be held in the near future to "sign up farmers for production of Brussels sprouts and to provide instruction in the growing of this crop."

"Seed for this first crop for the plant is already on its way from British Columbia."

The company hopes that each farmer involved will be willing to grow at least two acres of the crop, but it will work with farmers who want to grow less.

"Spraying operations will be conducted by the company this year, but a limited amount of spraying equipment is available. It is hoped that crops will be grown as close to plant as possible."

Mr. Daley said the company will make use of the advance registration of farmers, carried out in November by the department of agriculture and natural resources. "About 80 farmers have expressed willingness to grow crops for the plant," he said.
