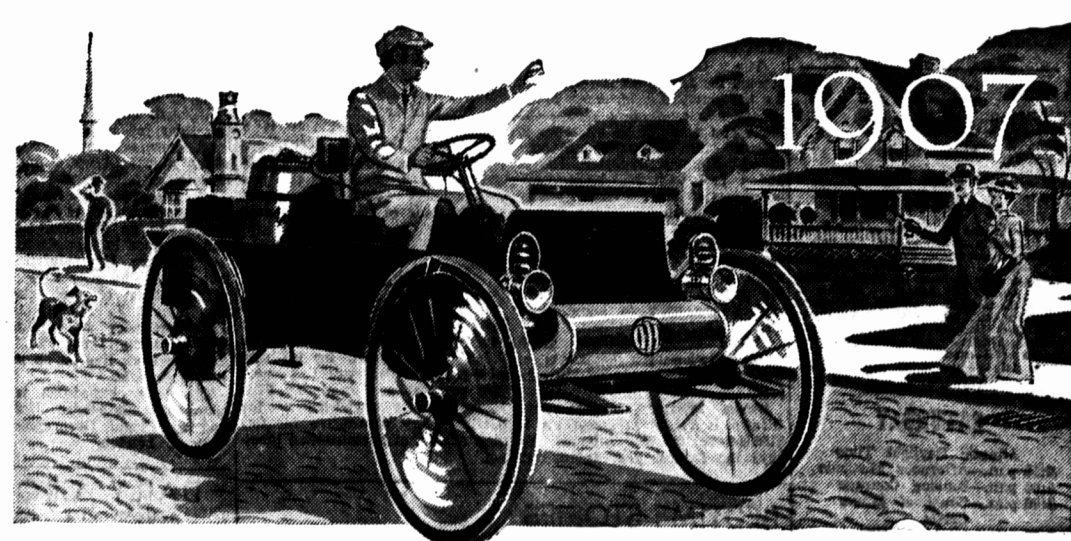

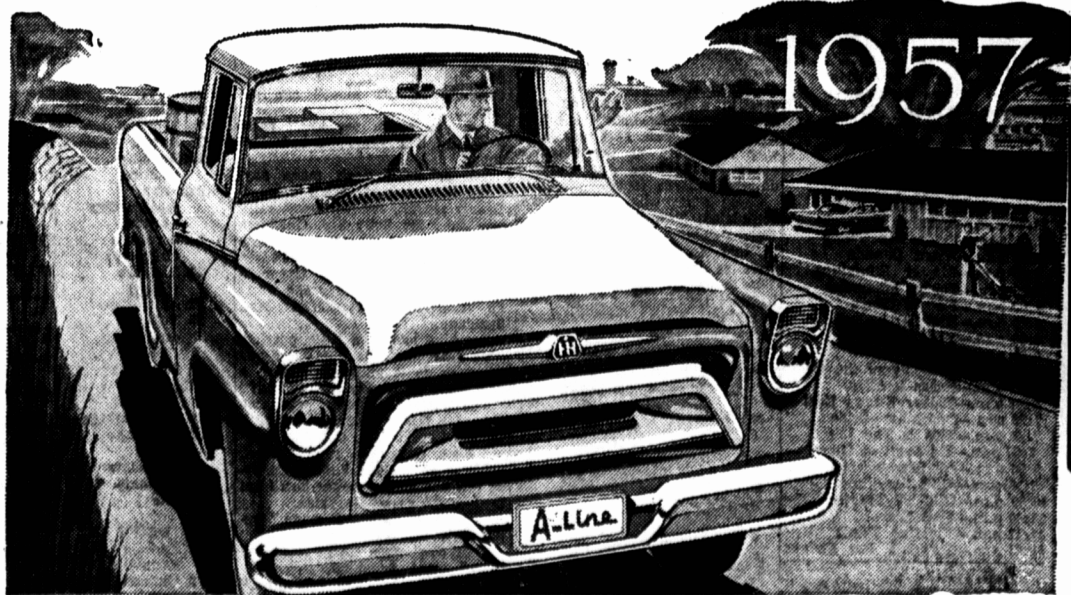

**Range Drawn As Prize At Cooking Demonstration**

The 4-burner electric range donated by R. T. Holman Ltd., in connection with the 5-day cooking school sponsored by Dominion Stores Ltd. was won by Mrs. J. C. Cook, 35 Upper Prince St., Charlottetown. The draw to choose the recipient of the major prize was conducted yesterday afternoon at the Community Centre. All those who attended one or

more of the cooking school sessions participated in the draw by depositing the B-portion of their door ticket in the container located at Holman's.  
This was not the only prize awarded during the five day event.
