(LD); **Red-tailed Hawk** - 1 at West Royalty on Dec. 8 (DCS), 1 regularly on power poles along TCH west of Crapaud in Dec. and early Jan. (BH), 2 near South Melville on Dec. 12 (RA) 1 at Crapaud, 1 at Albany, & 1 at Middleton seen repeatedly in Dec. 11 with one being seen all summer in Middleton as well (RA), 1 immature at Rocky Point feeder being harassed by crows on Dec. 30 (LD), 1 on Dec. 30 at South Melville (a local bird seen here all year 2001), 1 at Lakeside on Jan. 7 to 9 (ADM), 1 at Rocky Point feeder on Feb. 5 (LD), 1 near Brackley in Jan. (JDM); **Great Black-backed Gull** - abundant from Nov. 10 to 13 in north eastern PEI (PJ); **Ring-billed Gull** - common from Nov. 10 to 13 in north eastern PEI (PJ), at Wood Islands & Point Prim on Jan. 7 (DK, JB, LM, SC); **Herring Gull** - abundant from Nov. 10 to 13 in north eastern PEI (PJ); **Bonaparte's Gull** - common from Nov. 10 to 13 in north eastern PEI (PJ), 40
