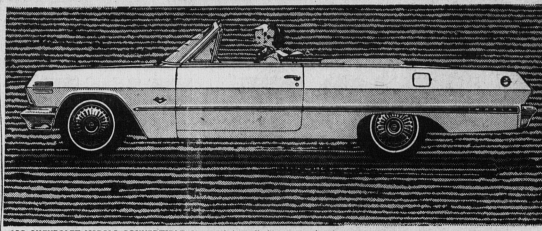

TV In Education Discussed At Conference In Moncton

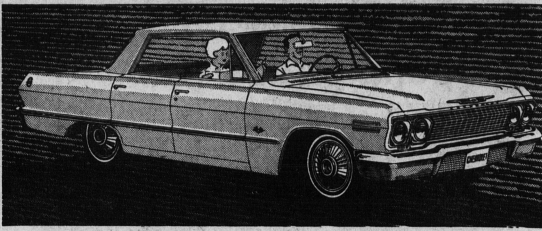

Dr. MacDiarmid said the education officials would meet again to decide whether such a program should be adopted. "We hope that the outcome will be that we will get it," he said.

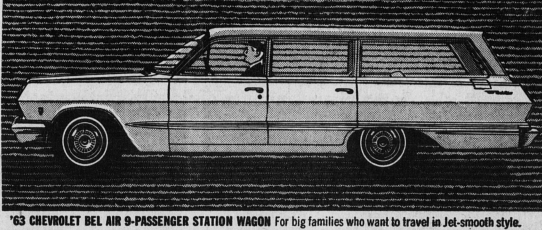
