Reynolds May Start World Series For Yanks

NEW YORK (AP)—The "big three" of the New York Yankees' pitching staff, Allie Reynolds, Vic Raschi and Ed Lopat, hope to continue their world series mastery when they face the Brooklyn Dodgers Wednesday.

The veteran hurlers have been good in their past series performances. Overall they have an impressive 14-5 won-lost mark. Reynolds is 6-2, Raschi 5-2 and Lopat 3-1. Reynolds, key man in the Yankee pitching rotation, is valuable both as a starting pitcher and as a reliever. The "chief" probably will get the opening day assignment at the Yankee Stadium Wednesday, opposing Brooklyn's ace, Carl Erskine.

Lopat is expected to follow Reynolds Thursday and Raschi is a good bet to get the call Friday when the teams switch to Ebbets Field for the third game.

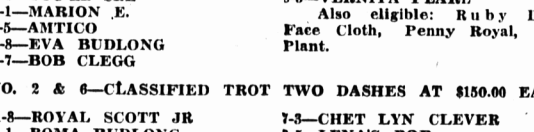
