MARKETS and FINANCE

By THE CANADIAN PRESS

Toronto: Industrials narrowly firmer; base metals weaker. New York: Stocks higher; trading active.

Montreal: Industrials firmer, trading moderately active.

New York (AP)—The stock market rolled ahead Wednesday with a great number of liberal gains in the list.

Most notable gainer was Chrysler which shot ahead 4 1/2 in a flurry of trading in the final hour. It was the day's second most active issue. General Motors paced Chrysler for a while, but only managed to rise 1 1/2 at 144 1/2.

The best acting major divisions included the motors, steels, rubbers, mail order houses, farm implements, and distillers, plus some oil, paper, and cement issues.

The aircrafts were neglected while chemicals, coppers, and radio-televisions were mixed.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was ahead 60 cents at \$180.60. That is equal to the record high mark established last Friday.

The industrial component was up \$1.50 at a high of \$256.40, but the railroads declined 10 cents while the utilities gained 10 cents.

Most active issue was Hupp Corp., up 1/4 at 7 1/2 on 44,200 shares.

Higher stocks included Distillers S. & G. a. r. m., up 1/2, Internationals Nickel and McIntyre, both up 1/4, and Canadian Pacific and Dome Mines, both ahead 1/4. Hiram Walker dropped 1/2.

Index changes: Golds up .08 to 86.94, base metals up 1.01 to 219.35, and western oils down 1.19 to 119.79.

Toronto (CP)—Base metals began the day strong then tumbled up some ground, but ended ahead on the stock market Wednesday.

Western oils were a little softer and gold mixed.

Bralorne was the star among mining issues, jumping 85 to \$5.10 and touching a high of \$5.25. Most of the senior base metals were fractionally higher. Granduc added 45 to \$8.75, Coldealm 24 to \$1.19 and Quebec Metallurgical 35 to \$5.60. Better goods included Pioneer, ahead 23 to \$2.15.

Losses in mines were mostly small, ranging to about 20 cents. Easier issues included Eastern Smelting, Opemiska, Lyndhurst, Consolidated Sudbury and Preston East Dome.

Commonwealth topped western oil gainers, up 50 to \$4.85. Other changes were limited to about 15 cents. Up were Canadian Atlantic, National Petroleum, Prairie, Liberal Petroleum and Atlantic, Canadian Southern, Canadian Devonian, Security and Gas Exploration eased lightly.

Montreal Stocks

MONTREAL (CP)—A firm undertone prevailed at the close of the stock market Wednesday. Trading was active in both the mining and industrial classifications.

Price movements were mostly of a fractional nature, although more than a dozen new highs were established for the year.

Papers and base metals were the trend leaders. Beverages in most instances were narrowly improved. Utilities, banks and seniors showed mixed tendencies. There were few price changes in the steels. Western oils were moderately active with the majority of issues displaying minus signs.

For and Ogilvie recent strong spots, each moved off 4 points. Among the bright performers were Howard Smith, International Paper, St. Lawrence, Noranda, BA Oil, Acconic and Mogador.
