6. More than 300 crippled children and adults in Prince Edward Island were helped in 1965.



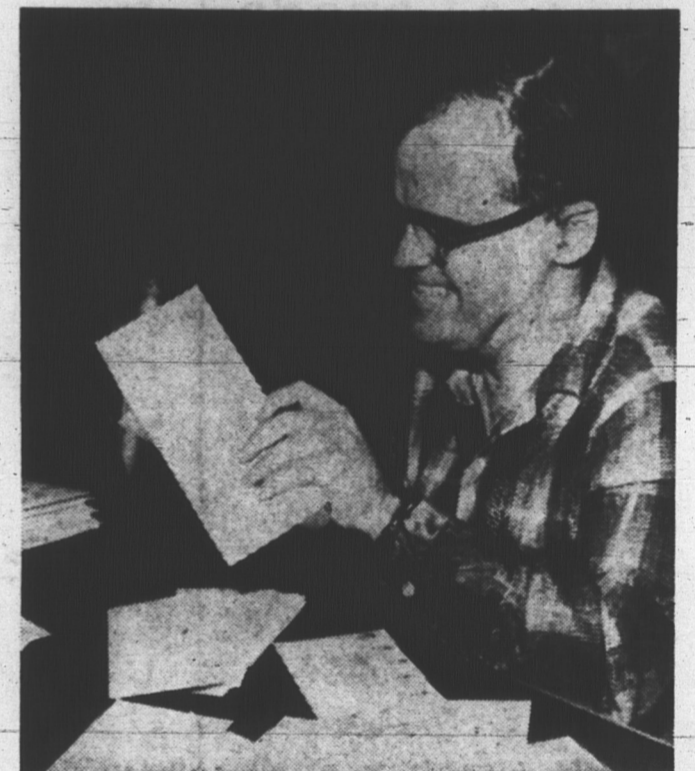

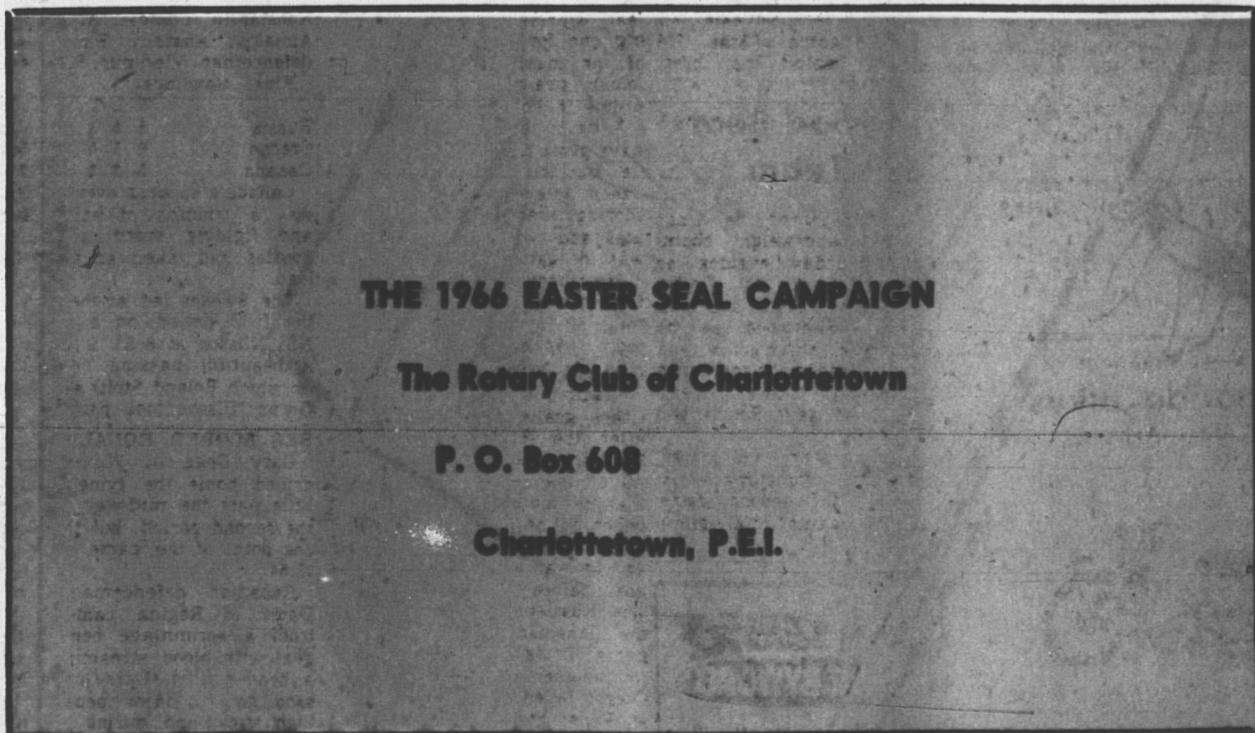
