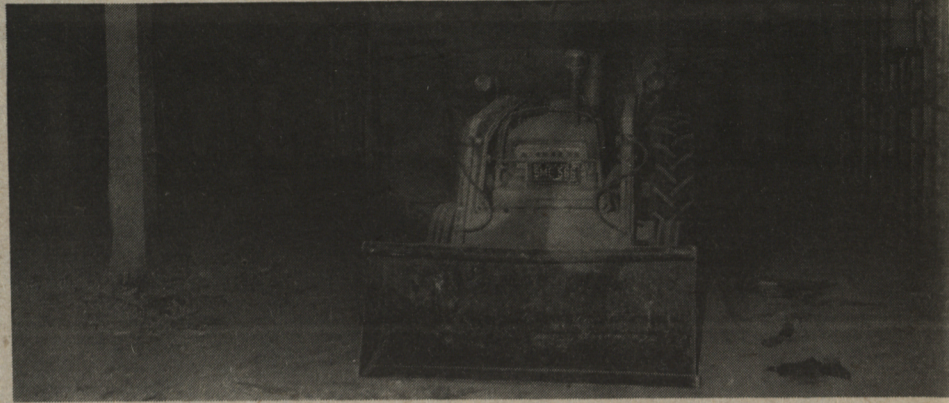

The project is to be finished for the '79-'80 academic year. With its completion, the old Education building will be removed as well as N and NA. Nothing is yet planned for the old Psych lab.

The new Memorial Hall will include a new wing of about 4000 sq. ft. It will have computer terminals

and will be accessible to the physically handicapped. This will include ramps, special washrooms and an elevator.

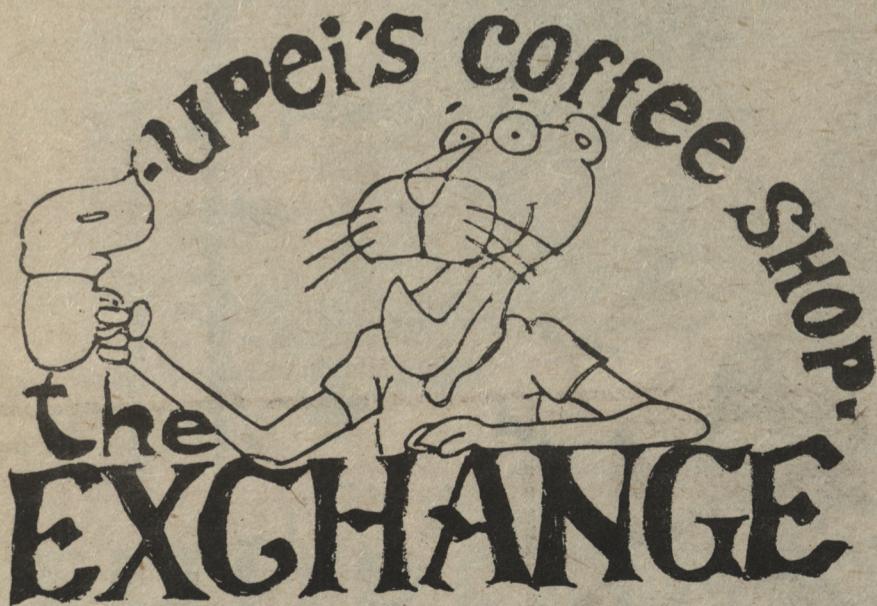
