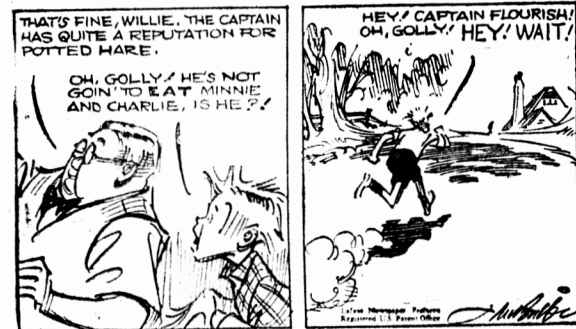

Contract Bridge

THE WRONG ARGUMENT!

As is so often the case, an argument over the bidding followed today's deal, when, as a matter of fact, the play had been the more important issue.

East dealer. North-South vulnerable.

10 3	K J 8 8
6 2	5 4
6 4	J 10 5 3
A Q J	8 3 2
10 8 7 3	

The bidding:

East	South	West	North
Pass	3 ♠	Pass	4 ♠
Pass	3 ♥	Pass	4 ♥
Dble.	Pass	Pass	Pass

West opened the diamond six. The king won, and the king and queen of trumps were cashed. When dummy's last trump was led to South's ace, the expected break was revealed, and South then ran the diamond suit. On the fourth round, East discarded a low spade he saw no good reason to disclose his strength in that suit.

Now, probably because he could see no better play, South took the spade finesse. East won, drew South's remaining trump, and simply exited with the spade jack. South then led a club and ducked in his own hand, so that he had to be given the club king, but the contract was down one trick.

North and South then argued about the bidding. North insisting that South should have let West play three clubs doubled; South defending his own action.

North was probably right, but the fact remains that South should have made his vulnerable four-heart contract! East's void in clubs was not difficult to visualize; hence, after cashing three trumps and the diamonds, ending in the closed hand, South should have thrown East in with the last trump! East would then have to give dummy two spade tricks and after cashing both of those tricks to extract West's ext. cards! South would merely have to lead a club and duck, as before. Thus he would win 10 tricks—and it is a fair conclusion that there would have been no argument over the bidding!

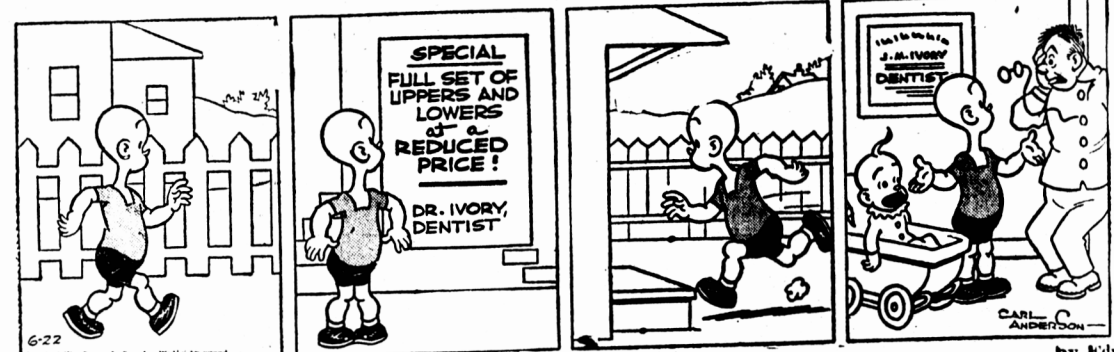

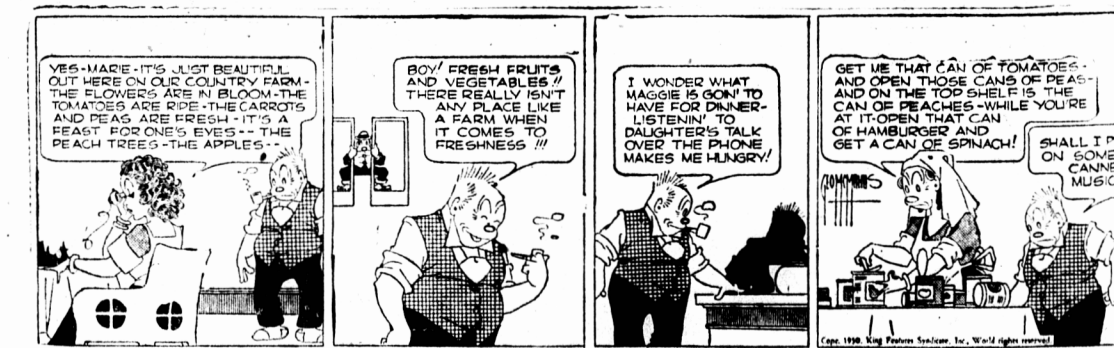
