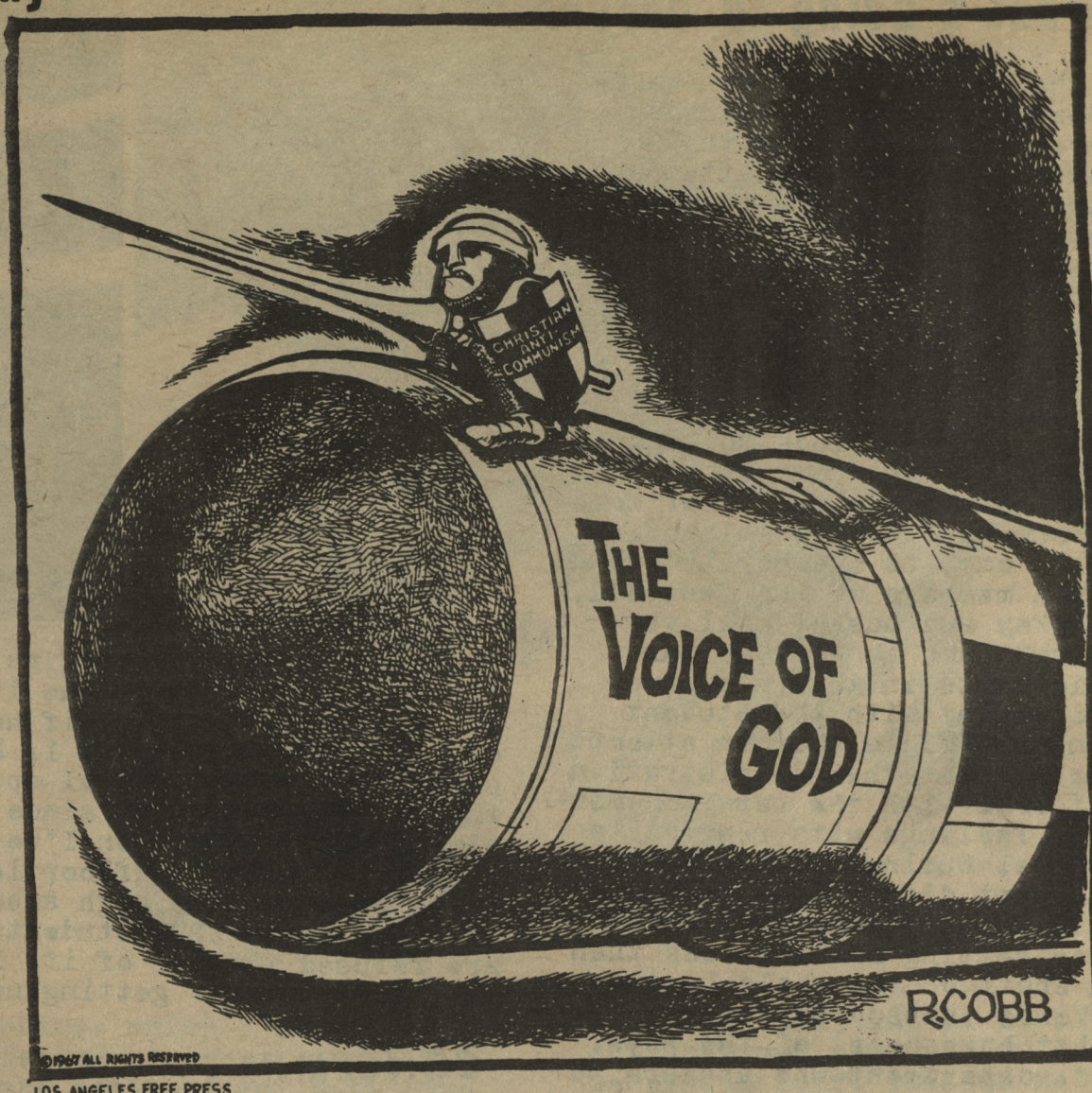


Presidential pledge re: apathy
