

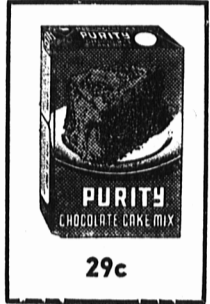

Mr. William MacDonald, Mrs. Charles MacDonald and Miss Mary Milligan were in Summerside on Saturday November 29th.

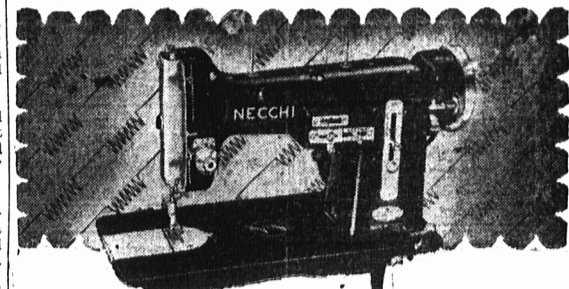
Miss Hazel Coughlin, Summerside, spent a few days with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Coughlin.

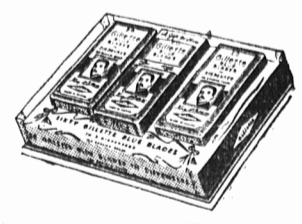
