NEW YORK (AP) - After two sessions of irregular trading, the stock market staged an upward advance Tuesday on the heaviest trading of 1964.

The market was mixed at the start but soon turned up and reached its peak in mid-afternoon. Thereafter gains were cut and some profit-taking was erased.

Wall Street had some bullish news to report. Steel production in the latest week was up 1.5 per cent from 10.7 million tons in June, prices for aluminum were rising, airlines had increasing passenger loads, and there was lessening concern about the Panama crisis.

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Among Canadian issues, traded Aluminum Ltd. gained 3/4, International & Hudson Bay 3/4, Walker Gooderham 1/2.

Prices on the American Exchange were generally lower. Security Rainbow Oil fell 1/4, Jupiter 3/4, Preston 1-1/2 and Canadian Pacific 1/2.

MONTREAL (CP) - The stock market forged ahead strongly Tuesday, with paper and metals the forefront on the Montreal and Canadian exchanges.

The composite index climbed 0.4 to 132.4. In paper, prices of the Index gained 1/8 to 130.7, Fraser and Brown added 3/4 each, MacMillan, Biondel 3/4 and Price Bros. 3/4.

Banks were 0.6 higher at 124. Bank Telephone rose 1/2. In senior base metals, Hollinger rose 1/2 and International 3/4.

Primary metals showed gains. Ontario Steel added 1/2, Dominion Steel, Aluminium and Alcan. 1/4 each.

Industries were 0.4 higher at 135.4. Dominion Oilfield, Fleetwood and Moore Corp. gained 1/2 each, Turnbull, Rockwell, Standard and Famous Players 1/4 each.

Trading among senior base metals was brisk during the morning session but reversed during the afternoon. International Nickel rose 1/2, Noranda gained one point to 29 in senior shares.

Trading in western oils was light and sporadic. A decline of 1/2 on speculative stocks showed little of the recent volume or drastic price changes.

Islo Mines, however, proved an exception and gained 2 1/2 points to 82 1/2 with volume of 107,500 shares. New Senator, Candore and Crownall traded between 120,000 shares and 142,000 shares.
