## Americans Pay Heavier Taxes

CHICAGO (AP)—A research organization says Americans are paying heavier federal taxes than their Canadian neighbors. Commerce Clearing House offered this comparison.

Assuming he takes the standard deduction and files a joint return, a married American with two children under 16 will have to pay \$290 in 1966 federal income taxes at the \$5,000 income level.

His counterpart in Canada will have to pay only \$205. At the \$10,000 income level, the U.S. taxpayer with a wife and two children under 16 will pay \$1,114 compared to the Canadian's payment of \$877.

The organization studies tax and business laws for its clients. The Canadian dollar is worth approximately 83 cents in relation to the United States dollar.
