So rapid has been the rate of late that one ought to pasture out with splendid results by the first of June. OUR LOBSTERS IN LONDON. Sir,—We have noted in your paper of 5th inst., a report of an interview between Mr. James Paton of your city and Messrs. Stebbing & Co., with reference to the present status of Prince Edward Island canned lobsters on our market. We venture to write confirming Mr. Stebbing's opinion. In a good many cases it is very difficult to get a fair sample and naturally the goods are looked at askance by large dealers here. We feel quite sure that while the large packers in your island are careful, the smaller ones (1) do not use tin plates of sufficiently good quality, and (2) are not so careful in selecting the fish as they should be; (3) the fish is not always properly cleaned, and a large proportion of small meat gets packed which is worthless. Inattention to these points tends to bring the island output into disrepute. We are inclined to think that Government inspection is exceedingly difficult to carry out, but on this point we cannot express a definite opinion. However we feel sure that if your packers would exercise a little more care, the market value of their output would be greatly increased. We can quote plenty of cases where samples sent forward were good, but the bulk on arrival had deteriorated, much to dealer's annoyance. CITY COUNCIL MEETING.

The regular monthly meeting of the City Council was held last night, Mayor Dawson presiding. Every member of the board was present. After routine, a letter was read from the Water Commissioners asking for an issue of debentures amounting to \$500 for repairs and extensions. It was decided to comply with the request. An application for the position of City Scavenger was read from Joseph Steele. It was referred to the Street Committee. A letter from A. P. Allen, claiming \$50 for injuries received by reason of a defective sidewalk was laid on the table. A tender was read from Thomas Campbell re the construction of a breastwork at the foot of Richmond Street West. Mr. Campbell offered to do the work for \$75, and to extend each of the three drains in the vicinity for \$5 each. No action was taken in the matter. Councillor Hazard then submitted the estimates of revenue and expenditure for the year as follows: EXPENDITURE. Each item was explained by Councillor Hazard and the reductions or increases pointed out and reasons therefor given. When the item for the macadamizing and maintenance of streets came up, Councillor Tanton put in a plea for more permanent improvements in the streets and sidewalks. He thought that a certain sum should be set apart each year for the putting down of stone or other permanent sidewalks. Councillor Hazard explained that there was \$750 in the estimates for this purpose. The people secured well pleased with the work done on the streets so far. There was also some discussion over the grant of \$350 for Queen Square Gardens, and the item subject to the conditions of a resolution introduced by Councillor Tanton providing in effect that the amount of the grant shall be expended exclusively for the benefit of the gardens, and that no money be devoted to the cultivating of flowers for sale. Councillor Hughes thought that some of the grant for the gardens should go towards furnishing band music, and trusted that a citizens' meeting would be held to consider this matter. On the item of \$2000 for the park roadway, Councillor Hazard went into the history of the movement, and pointed out that it had been ascertained that the City was entitled to about 100 feet more of the land along the shore front than it was thought they were entitled to. The whole cost of the roadway would be about \$4000. The roadway would be of great advantage to the citizens, and besides it would be a protection to City property. He hoped that the work would be commenced soon. How the work will be done is a matter for future consideration. Councillor Tanton thought that as the construction of the roadway would add materially to the value of the Government property, the Government should pay a proportion of the cost. Government House property might at some time be sold in building lots. Councillors Fenell and Taylor spoke in favor of protecting the city's land and proceeding with the roadway. Councillor Hughes did not think Government House property would ever be sold in building lots. If Government House were abolished he thought the people would insist upon having the whole property turned into one magnificent park. Mayor Dawson expressed the opinion that as the proposed roadway would protect Dominion and Local Government property, both Governments should bear a share of the cost of construction. Councillor Hazard then introduced the by-law referring and specifying the rates of assessment for general civic and water purposes, which were read a first and second time in committee with Councillor Hooper in the chair. The rate of assessment for general civic purposes was fixed at 1 per cent each. For waterworks purposes the rate was fixed at 1-8 of 1 per cent on real estate and personal property, and 10 cents on polls. The usual by-law allowing a rate of discount on taxes was also read a first and second time. It was decided to allow 2 1/2 per cent on taxes paid before the 15th July. The by-laws were all ordered to be read a third time at next meeting of Council. Councillor Hughes moved that the Fire Board be requested to place a fire alarm at the eastern end of Fitzroy Street, near the Railway. Council adjourned until Tuesday evening at 7.30.
