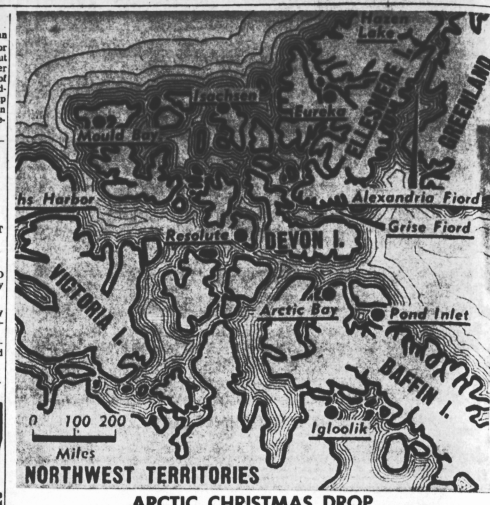

ARCTIC CHRISTMAS DROP

An RCAF aircraft from Nanaimo, near Edmonton, is making the first Christmas supply drop to Arctic outposts.

Working out of Resolute, on Cornwallis Island, 1,800 miles northeast of Edmonton, the bar-

rel-delivered C-119 Flying Boxcar scheduled drops to numerous stations, mostly manned by about eight federal transport depart-ment employees and United States weather station men.

Arctic stops included Isachsen, Eureka, Snow, Mould Bay, Alex-

andria Fiord, Pond Inlet, Arctic Bay, Igloolik, Hazel Lake, Sachs Harbor and Grise Fiord.

Each station receives about 600 pounds of food and parcels, dropped by parachute from a height of 400 feet. (CP News-photos)

Soviet Will Try For The Moon

LONDON (Tuesday) (AP)—Moscow Radio broadcast Monday a prediction by a Soviet scientist that the Soviet Union will send a rocket to the moon within the next 18 to 24 months.

Prof. K. Stanukovich of the Soviet commission for interplanetary travel said the necessary velocity to escape the earth's gravitational grip, a velocity which about seven miles a second, can be achieved by adding one or two stages to modern ballistic rockets.

The two Soviet Sputniks now circling the earth were launched at a velocity of about five miles a second.

Stanukovich wrote in a magazine article quoted in the broadcast that the first moon rockets probably will carry a powerful explosive which will flatten the moon's surface could be seen from the earth.

Eventual use of a n e e d rockets will land on the Moon, he said, adding:

"There is no doubt a splendid astronomical observatory will be set up there. The moon might be come an aerodrome for space ships and a laboratory for future atomic researchers."
