Foreign Ministry of Ecuador warns it will not tolerate U.S. intervention in its internal affairs.

According to news reports the Gov't of Ecuador made public a message sent to Washington last month in which it was made clear in very strong terms that no intervention in Ecuador's internal affairs would be tolerated.

This was made public knowledge after a local paper reported that the United States would view with great satisfaction the granting of a concession to exploit oil in the Gulf of Guayaquil to the U.S. firm ADA.

(C.I.A.) The Foreign Ministry statement says Ecuador will not tolerate any intervention, no matter how subtle or delicate in its internal affairs.



Chile - Trials of Don Quixote in Facist Chile

The ultrareactionary Chilean daily "El Mercurio" reported only recently that the fascist junta had decided to eliminate a number of Spanish classics - Don Quixote - among them, from literature courses. It seems that these fascist lackeys consider the valiant knight-errant a suspicious character, a Marxist.

The drastic measure comes of no surprise to either the people of Chile or anybody else since September 11, 1973. Fascists Commit Yet Another Crime:

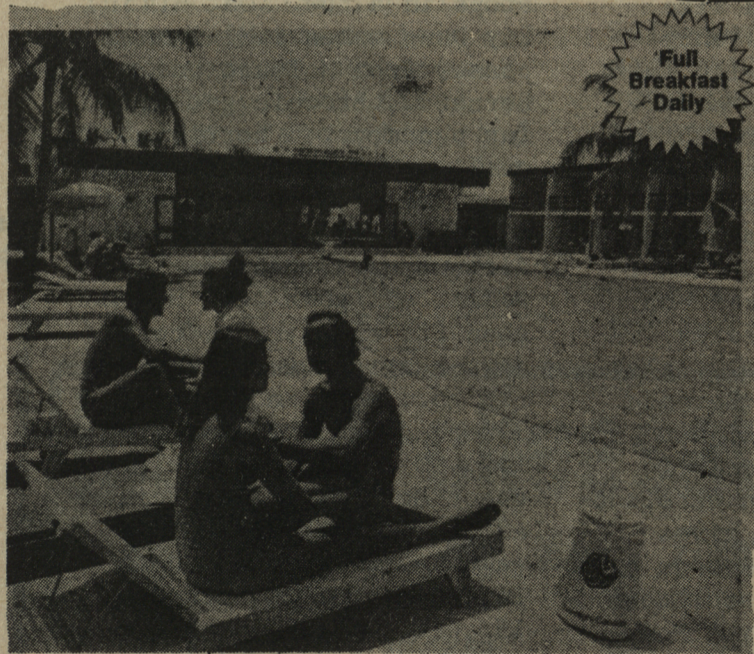
