

Directors Vote No Dividend

DETROIT (AP)—Directors of American Motors voted Monday for the fourth consecutive quarter to omit payment of a dividend as earnings nosedived over those of a year ago.

AMC's net earnings for the third quarter of its fiscal year were \$22,341 on net sales of \$228,045,377.

A year ago, the earnings were \$6,932,850, or 37 cents a share on net sales of \$270,368,133.

AMC said "all 1965 figures have been restated to include the accounts of Canadian subsidiaries."

For the nine months of the current fiscal year, the fourth largest auto producer in the U.S. reported a net loss of \$4,141,063, or 22 cents a share on net earnings of \$707,132,291.

The company's net earnings for the nine months of 1965, net earnings were \$18,240,926 or 99 cents a share on net sales of \$834,208,097.

AMC said its worldwide vehicle sales since Oct. 1, 1965, totalled 288,376 vehicles compared with 32,478 for the same period a year ago. The third-quarter figures were 90,015, this time compared with 114,434 for the same period a year ago.

AMC said its Kelvinator division sales were up seven per cent for the first nine months and the third quarter of the fiscal year compared with 1965 figures. Dollar totals were not disclosed.

AMC's last dividend was a 12 1/2-cent payment made the quarter ended Sept. 30, 1965.

Doctors Doing Kitchen Work

MONTREAL (CP)—Laundry and kitchen work by specialist doctors, initiated at two Montreal hospitals during the current Quebec hospital strike, was extended to other hospitals Monday under the auspices of the Federation of Medical Specialists.

Members of the 3,500-strong federation had been undertaking service chores at the Montreal General and Royal Victoria hospitals during the walkout of non-medical employees. The federation is not involved in the dispute and has taken a neutral stand.

Dr. Bernard Perex, director of emergency service at the Royal Victoria, said the specialists are devoting several hours a day to laundry, kitchen and other duties because of a shortage of lay volunteers and because other workers such as nurses and physiotherapists are feeling the strain of extra hours spent on service duties.

Dr. Perex said doctors work four-hour service shifts, leaving them time to fulfill their clinical responsibilities.

In some cases, doctors have cut their vacations short, returning with their wives and older children to help with service work.

Dief Back For Cup Of Coffee

THREE HILLS, Alta. (CP)—Opposition Leader Diefenbaker returned Monday to this central Alberta farming community for a cup of coffee he had to turn down last fall.

During the last federal election campaign, Mr. Diefenbaker's train was running late. He had to turn down an invitation for coffee but promised he'd be back for it as soon as he could.

He was invited to attend a luncheon Monday for community leaders and to visit the 900-student Prairie Bible Institute, an evangelical missionary training college.

Three Hills, population 1,500, is about 60 miles northeast of Calgary.

Mr. Diefenbaker came here from Calgary, where he reiterated charges that the federal government's land-leasing policies in national parks are "unworkable and unjust."

He said in an interview the policies, under which leases run 45 years and then land and any buildings revert to the Crown, are "completely devoid of fair recognition of the rights of private enterprise."

The Opposition leader was tanned after a 17-day vacation at Hot Springs, B.C.
