1 cup sifted Swans Down Cake Flour
1 tspn. Calumet Baking Powder
1/4 tspn. salt
1/4 tspn. mace
2 eggs, unbeaten
2/3 cup sugar
2 tbspns. shortening
1/2 cup hot milk
1/2 tspn. grated lemon rind

Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder, salt and mace. Sift together three times. Beat eggs with rotary egg beater until they are foamy throughout. Add sugar gradually, beating constantly until very thick and light. Add shortening to hot milk and heat until melted; then add to egg mixture, mixing quickly. Add all flour and lemon rind and beat with rotary egg beater smooth. Turn into round 8-inch layer pan, 1 1/2 inches deep, which has been lined on bottom with paper, but not greased. Bake in moderate oven (375°F.) about 15 minutes. Cool in pan. Cut cake in half. Spread whipped cream or custard filling between halves. Sift powdered sugar over top of cake.
