M. F. Schurman was born at Freeport, P. E. Island. He started in the Lumber and Contracting business at Kensington in 1896, formed a Joint Stock Company in 1907 and bought out the present mill property at Summerside, now known as M. F. Schurman Co., Limited. This Company not only carried on the lumbering and contracting business at Summerside but has continued to operate at Kensington as well. Mr. Schurman has been President and General Manager continuously since the Company was organized. He has also served twelve years at the Town Council Board and was most instrumental in saving the Electric Light Property for the Town, and which since has proven to be such a splendid asset. He married Sarah Beattie of Summerside.



W. P. CALLAGHAN

Born in Miminingash in 1869; engaged for several years in fishing and farming; conducted machine and carriage business in Tignish, as well as in insurance for a period of ten years. Engaged in business at St. Louis from 1908-1930; further active in the Fox Industry from 1912, with the ranches both in Canada and the United States. Moved to Summerside in 1933 and organized the Dominion Silver Fox Co., officiating as Managing Director and Vice-President for two years, and upon resignation devoted entire time in the Wholesale Coal business, founding his own company, and in which company is still active. Religion, Roman Catholic.



LOWELL WILSON HANCOCK

Descended from old English stock tracing back to Hancock Biruno of Yorkshire (1273 A.D.) in English records. Born in Clermont County, Ohio. Attended Ohio State University in 1919 to 1923, graduating with Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture, 1923; majoring in Animal Husbandry. Several hours work is also on record at the same University on a Master of Science degree. Came to Prince Edward Island 1924 and again 1925 to enter Silver Fox Industry. Operates a Fox and Mink Ranch. Founded International Fox & Animal Foods, Ltd., Manufacturers of Single Fox-Mink-Poultry & Livestock Feeds. Also International Products Company, Manufacturers of Breakfast Cereals, Specialties, etc. Founded the first Maritime Fur Study Club, which has been the original instigator of Government Fur Field Men; Federal Illustration Stations; group system of Judging foxes; Fur Field Days; and perfected the First Record of Performance Record System for Foxes in the World. Active in cooperative movements, musical circles, civic improvements, and is Past President of the Summerside Y's Men's Club.



F. J. E. WRIGHT

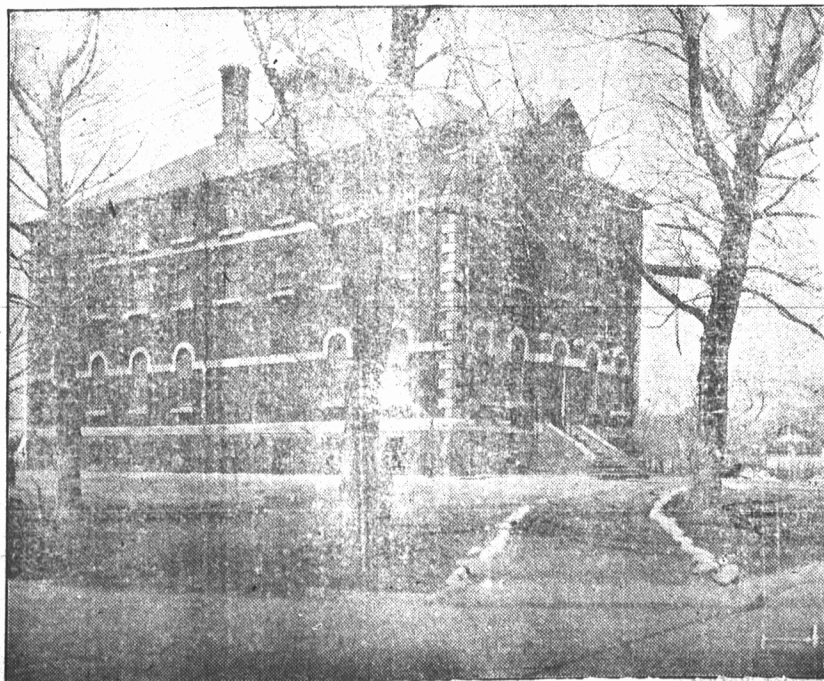
