Five young people, four from the same family, died in this mangled wreck when the car collided with a light truck, killing a sixth person, a youth driving the truck. Dead are Douglas Parkinson, 17, driver of the car, his sister Brenda, 9, brothers, Ronald, 7, Daniel, 13, all of Denfield, Ont.; their cousin Thomas Sheehoborn, 15, of Ilderton, Ont. and Bruce Monthy, 17, of Belton, Ont., driver of the truck. Shows Slow Harvesting On Prairies
OTTAWA (CP)—Cool showery weather on the Prairies has delayed harvesting of a large proportion of this year's above-average grain crop. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics reported Wednesday.
Crop yields so far are generally bearing out earlier estimates. Light frosts have occurred in all three Prairie provinces. Both Mrs. Thomas Bartlett, and Gertrude and one brother George predeceased him.
