WINNIPEG, July 28 - (CP) - Fair exports in Canadian barley was noted today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Trade reports indicated probably 500,000 bushels had been sold to the continent. Some shipping demand was noted in oats and modest support from exporters and industrial interests appeared in flax. Prices held to a narrow margin and were irregular most of the session.
