MONTREAL (CP) - Sattered gains ranged over a point Wednesday as industrial stocks on the Montreal and Canadian exchanges closed generally higher in a session of moderate trading.

Nova Scotia improved a point in a fractionally better group. In the refining oils Imperial added a point in the pipeline. International jumped 2 1/2 to lead the papers higher.
