

Investment Opportunities Are Reported From Japan

VANCOUVER (CP)—The expanding industrial complex of Japan offers good investment opportunities for Canadians, says A. G. All Thompson, vice-chairman of the Vancouver Stock Exchange.

Interviewed upon his return from a three-week tour of Japan, he said Canada needs great infloves of invested capital to continue industrial expansion programs.

"We saw a great deal, were impressed by their industries and their activity and became more aware of their problems, especially as they are related to Canada," he said.

"I would say our trip was

probably be overdone," he said.

"Canada and Japan don't have a tax convention, but I understand talks on this question are starting in Ottawa."

"Japan has some currency restrictions, which will be relaxed in July and they will be allowed to buy our securities. If we invest in Japan we can realize our money with no difficulty."

Mr. Thompson said the Vancouver exchange has discussed with the Toronto Stock Exchange the possibilities of listing some Japanese stocks on the board.

"There are some mechanical difficulties," he said.

"But the Japanese stock market looks pretty attractive," he said. "There is renewed interest and they look for an active and higher market."
