NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP)—After four days of fast retreat, the stock market made a rally Friday but the pace of trading was more than 2,000,000 shares below volume for the previous session. The Dow Jones industrial average advanced 5.21 to 881.70, recouping about 20 per cent of the week's worst loss.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks rose 2 1/2 to 321 3/4 with industrials up 4 1/2, rails up 3 1/2 and utilities up 2. Of 135 issues traded, 692 rose and 428 fell. Canadian Pacific gained 1 1/4 among Canadian issues traded, while Aluminium Ltd. was up and Hudson Bay Mining was up. Distillers Seagrams lost 1/4 and Granby Mining and Walker Gooderham 1/4 apiece.

Prices were generally higher on the American exchange. Preston rose 1/4 and Canadian Marconi and Canadian Javelin 1/4 apiece. Brazilian Tractron dropped 1/4.

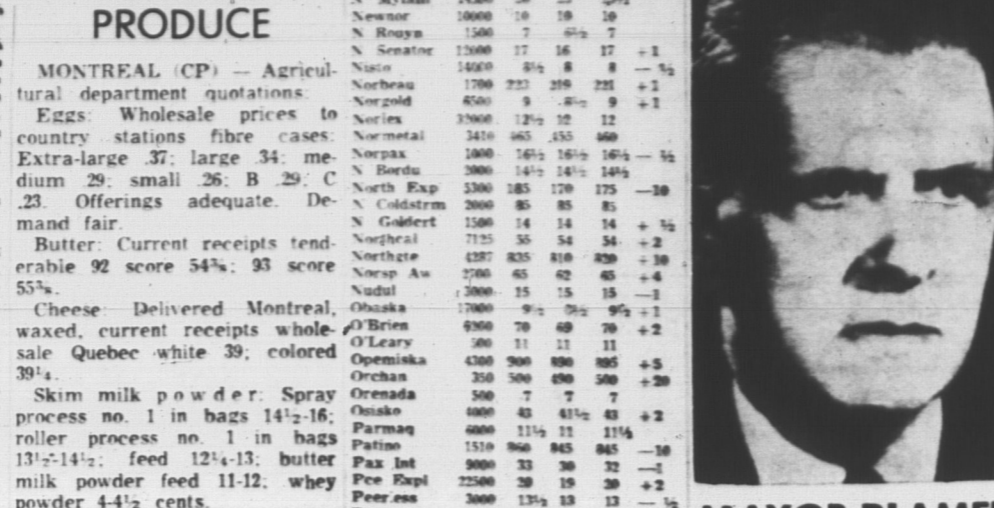
