

Pressurized Hopper Cars Latest Step Of Railways

MONTREAL (CP) — Pressure from shippers across Canada has prompted the CNR and CPR to invest heavily in more specialized freight equipment and start a pressure play of their own.

The latest step in the trend toward more sophisticated equipment is a 100-ton capacity pressure unloading hopper car now being put into service by both railways.

CPR has purchased 20 of the covered cars from National Steel Car in Hamilton, Ont. while the CNR has made two in its own shops and leases 30 others from North American Car Corp.

"They are the spearhead of the freight car revolution," said a CNR spokesman. "The pressure is on us so we're using a bit of pressure ourselves."

The pressure system speed up the unloading operation, cut down handling costs, provides all-weather protection for the cargo during unloading and eliminates the need for permanent unloading facilities other than an air compressor and storage silos.

Like conventional covered hopper cars, the new cars are loaded through hatches on top. The big difference is in the unloading operation.

Compressed air is used to agitate the cargo and force it through outlets in the bottom of the cars into pipes, then directly into trucks silos or any container. The cargo need never be exposed to the weather.

The end of the discharge pipe can be shifted from one side of the car to the other so that unloading can be done on either side of the tracks—an important

Centennial Is Linked With Expo

OTTAWA (CP) — The grand conductor of Canada's centennial celebrations says it's a myth that Expo 67 is in competition with the commission charged with ensuring Canada celebrates her 100th birthday in proper style.

Centennial Commissioner John Fisher told the closing session of the three-day federal-provincial talks on tourism and travel that if the international exhibition at Montreal next year falls "it hurts us in the centennial as well."

The tourist talks have been closed except for a session Tuesday and an hour Wednesday as the meetings were ending.

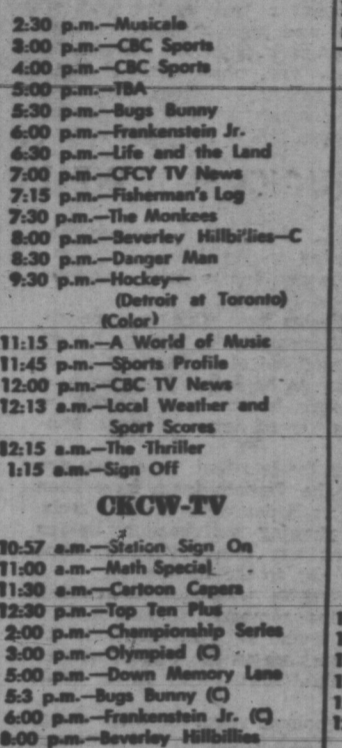
Proceedings were summarized in a concluding statement by T. R. G. Fisher, assistant deputy minister of trade and commerce, who said the centennial theme was that "centennial year is not a goal but a launching pad" for Canada's tourist industry.

Delegates laid plans for the years after 1967, including a decision to conduct more research at the federal and provincial level to establish guidelines to develop the industry to its full potential.

It was also decided to examine proposals that governments get together in developing a comprehensive tourist research blueprint for the next 10 years.
