Two Forestry Engineers Urge Increased Federal Assistance

OTTAWA (CP) — Two well-known Canadian forestry engineers Monday urged increased federal assistance to help the

provinces develop and protect their forestry resources. Maj. - Gen. Howard Kennedy, chairman of the Eastern Rockies forest conservation board, and G. W. I. Creighton, Nova Scotia's deputy minister of lands and forests, made the recommendation at a meeting of the Commons mines and forests committee.

Gen. Kennedy appeared before the committee in his capacity as a forest engineer. Mr. Creighton appeared as president of the Canadian Institute of Forestry.

They said the provinces require financial assistance mainly for the construction of trunk roads into forest areas.

DESERVE MORE HELP
Provincial governments, Mr. Creighton said, "are deserving of a great deal more help from the federal government than they have enjoyed up to now."

Gen. Kennedy said a "new look" is being taken in Canada at the forestry business and "we feel the federal government should take a new look at the help it now is providing."
