WINNIPEG, April 27 - (CP) - Prices of coarse grain futures moved irregularly during fairly active trade on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange Today. Fair commercial demand was shown in both oats and barley and offerings increased. Trade came in mostly for local trade although some American interest was evident. Close to 2,000,000 bushels of Canadian wheat was allocated during the last two days. The United Kingdom received 1,000,000 bushels while Belgium took 500,000 bushels and South Africa 365,000 bushels. Smaller amounts were distributed among Colombia, Ecuador and Costa Rica.

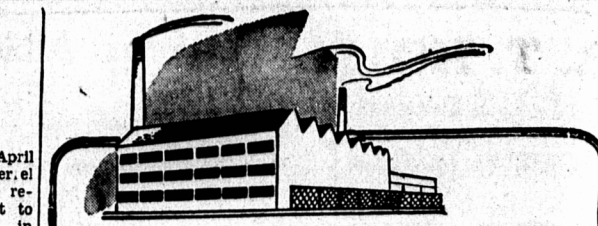
