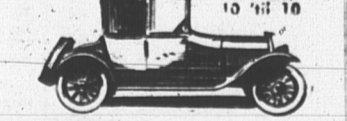
Accompanying the remains to the Province was the late Mr. Compton's nephew, Harry Barnes of Boston, Mass., and formerly of Georgetown.

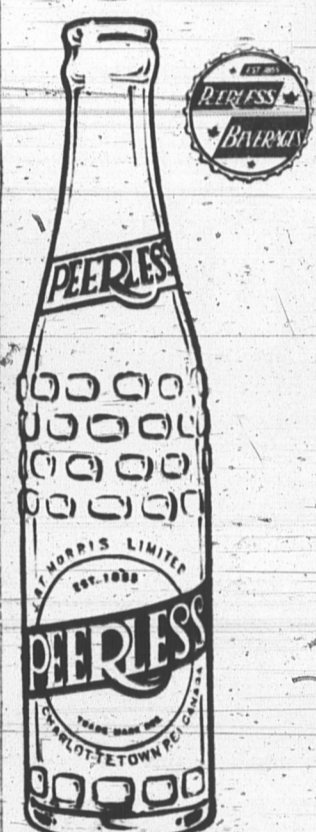

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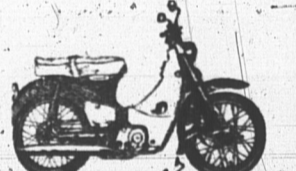

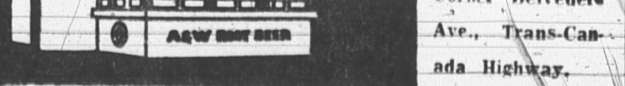
