New York Stocks NEW YORK, (AP) - The stock market put on a mild imitation of firmness Friday but developed a tired look at the close. The AP average of 60 stocks managed a gain of 10 cents that put the average up to \$125.90, the highest since October of 1929. Volume was down to 1,580,000 shares. General Electric topped the most active list for the third straight day. It remained unchanged at 42 7-8 on 31,400 shares. Baltimore and Ohio was second up 7-8 at 23 7-8. Canadian Pacific. Which has a steady demand throughout, was third up 3-8 at 28 1-8. Among higher stocks were U. S. Steel, Republic Steel, Chrysler, Studebaker, Montgomery Ward, United Aircraft, Phelps Dodge, Dow Chemical, Westinghouse Electric, Glenn Martin, Johns-Manville, New York Shipbuilding, Chicago Pneumatic Tool and U. S. Gypsum. Lower stocks included Goodyear, Boeing, Schenley Industries, Radio Corp., Kennecott Copper, Northern Natural Gas, Devoe and Reynolds. "A" Santa Fe, New York Central, Deep Rock Oil and Union Oil of California. Canadian oil shares on the American stock exchange were held hard by the decision of the federal power commission to permit Pacific Northwest Pipeline to supply gas from the United States to the Pacific northwest. That move cut off the possibility that Canadian gas would be used. Trading on the American amounted to 630,000 shares.
