New Year's Calls in New York.

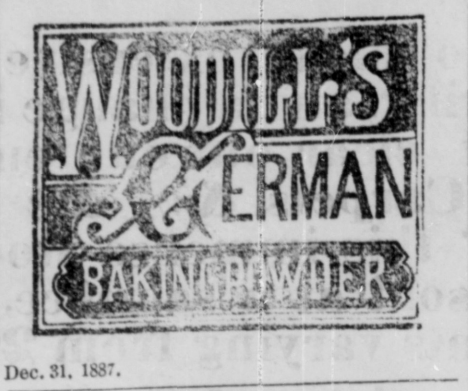
The custom of receiving calls on New Year's Day, so long a distinctive New York institution, has almost died out.

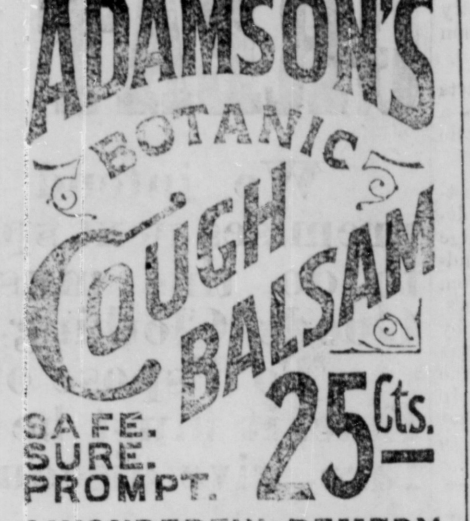

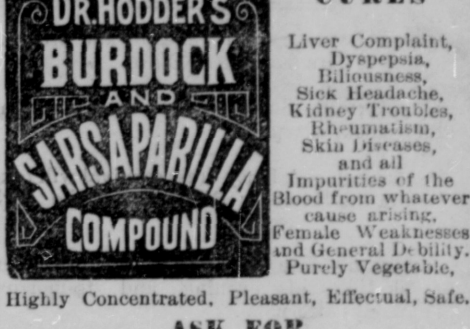
