

Company Plans Road Project

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP) — Premier Smallwood has announced his government had granted a 100-foot-wide right-of-way to the Julian Iron Company for construction of a 17-mile road between a Wabush Lake and Julian Lake in Labrador.

The company, a subsidiary of Canadian Javelin Limited, plans a \$1,000,000 iron ore mining and concentrating operation at Julian Lake, site of a proved deposit of 300,000,000 tons of ore.

The premier's announcement said the company will build a 40-foot-wide road and plans to finish it in eight weeks. It will extend from the deposit area at Julian Lake to the Wabush Lake pilot plant which will concentrate the ore.

The company plans to ship its first ore next spring.

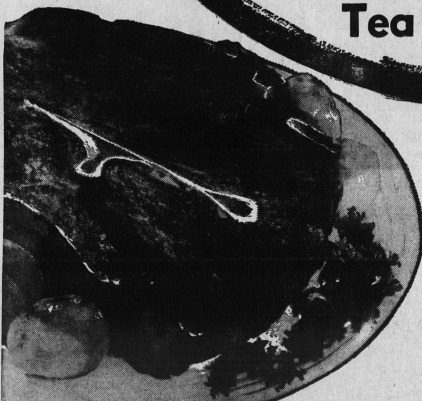
